- The course will be conducted over a period of 7 consecutive days.
- Day 1–2: Theory Classes, Day 3: Simulation Training, Day 4–7: Flying Sessions (Each trainee will be allotted approximately 4 hours of flying time, subject to weather and operational conditions.)
- Successful completion of a Course will make a participant eligible for a DGCA license with a validity of 10 years. The participant must clear each stage—Theory, Simulator, and Practical Flying— before progressing to the next stage.
- Trainees must qualify at each stage—theory, simulation, and flying—to successfully complete the course. A maximum of two attempts will be provided to clear each stage. Progression to the next phase is strictly contingent on successful completion of the preceding one.
- 100% attendance is mandatory for successful completion of the course.
- Accommodation and transport arrangements at RRU are subject to availability and will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Charges for accommodation and transport will be informed at the time of confirmation.
- Mess facility is available at RRU at subsidized rates.
- Candidates must carry the payment receipt, which will serve as the gate pass.
